

## North Fork Special Service District Service Fees

### Fire Protection Fees:

- .1580% of the Current Market Value of each property according to the Utah County Property Assessment. This calculated value is then divided by 12 to determine the monthly charge. Effective October 2017.

### Water Usage Fees:

Monthly connection fee for each connection base rate effective January 2020 Resolution 2019-2  
Includes 8,000 gallons or less

1" or less Meter:	\$61.14
1.5" Meter:	\$178.75
2" Meter:	\$262.52
2.5" Meter:	\$769.00 (*Construction or hydrant meter rental)
3" Meter	\$532.74
4" Meter	\$884.44
6" Meter	\$1,758.54 (*Reduced to 3" charges for a 1-year period)
8" Meter	\$2,625.76
10" Meter	\$3,741.23

- \$3.16 per 1,000 gallons over 8,000 gallons used up to 12000
- \$4.74 per 1,000 gallons over 12,000 gallons used up to 18000
- \$6.33 per 1,000 gallons over 18,000

\* Customers wanting to use water from a fire hydrant must contact the Director of Public Works 3 business days in advance and arrange for a hydrant meter.

Use in excess of 40,000 gallons per month is not considered reasonable for customary residential use. District policy states that excessive users may be subject to termination of service.

If users are charged for water overages, and discover and repair a leak causing the overages, they may apply to the Public Works Director for a one-time 50% credit on the most recent bill.

Even if water services are terminated, homeowners are still required to pay the water fees as long as there is a working meter on their property.

### Garbage Fees:

- \$10.15 per month for each residential account (excluding lots and Sundance units)
- Commercial accounts are charged at 10 times the rate of residential accounts.

All residents with a home on their property are required to pay the garbage fees regardless of occupancy or compactor use. Owners with lots only are not permitted to use our compactor.

### Sewer Fees:

Revised 7/31/2020 eaj

- \$62.96 per month per Residential Toilet Equivalent (RTE) effective September 2017

#### Late Fees:

- \$15 late fee if payment is not received 30 days from bill date
- Interest of 1.5% will be charged monthly starting at 60 days late
- \$35 for returned check fee

#### Reconnection Fees:

- \$150 plus account must be brought current

#### New Connection Fees

New connections require the following:

- The equivalent of 1 acre foot from Provo Reservoir Water Users Assoc. Other water shares require a point of diversion
- \$800 Reservoir Storage Water fee
- Connection Fee
  - \$2,500 for ¾"
  - \$3,500 for 1"
- Meter can and setter for \$600 with the district paying for the meter and transmitter

#### Mitigation Work

- \$100 per hour for a crew of up to 4 firefighters to do mitigation work around an owner's property. Includes power tools, chainsaws, and wood chipper as needed. Work includes tree trimming, felling trees under 6" diameter, and wood chipping.

Owners requesting mitigation work need to get a written bid with an estimate and terms from the fire department before work begins. All bids include a free risk assessment for the property.
